Jireh School was established in 2001 as a private school serving the Christian community of Kumeu. In 2006 Jireh became a state integrated school with a Christian character as a satellite of KingsWay School in Orewa. The school is a Primary School Year 1 to 6.

FACILITIES: The school has 4 teaching classrooms. The facilities include: a library, the use of a full sized gymnasium, a computer suite, hall, auditorium, music room, interview room, tutorial room, an arts and technology room. There are withdrawal spaces for small group teaching or remedial assistance, office block, sick bay, two fields, a sports shed and a playground.
