

Policy: Civil Defence Emergency

Policy Statement

Jireh Christian School ("the School") recognises its responsibility to ensure the safety of its students and staff in the case of a Civil Defence emergency. In the event of an emergency, the safety of the staff and students of the School is paramount.

Procedural Guidelines

- 1. The School will have in place a set of procedures specific to each hazard. The staff will follow the steps to ensure the safety of all concerned.
- 2. The School will follow the Civil Defence Plan contained in the document.
- 3. The School will liaise with the Auckland Council Civil Defence headquarters and other emergency services.
- 4. The School will act as a back-up facility in an emergency.
- 5. Civil Defence Emergency Response documentation is to be held at the Ovffice and the meeting room.
