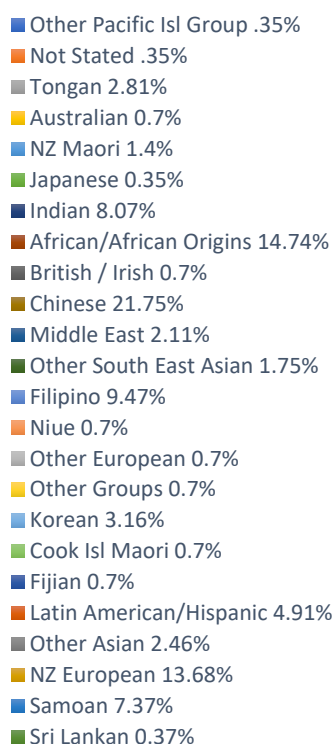
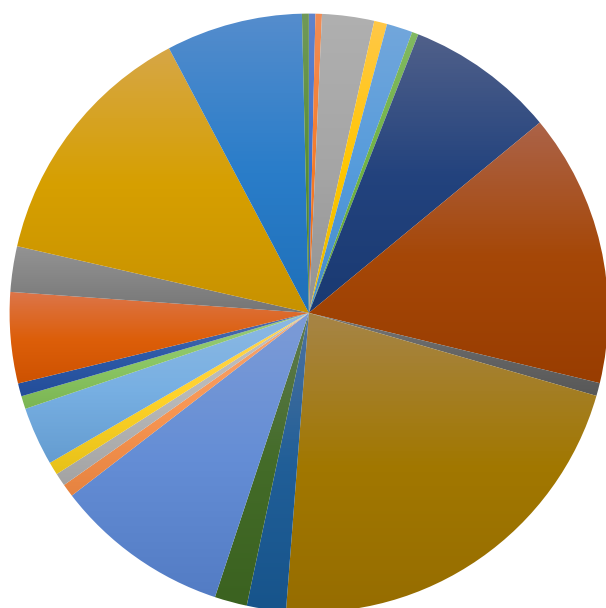

FACILITIES:

The school has 13 classrooms. There is a science laboratory, library, Makerspace (STEAM and cooking), a Music/Dance/Drama space, Learning Support room, and an ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) room. There are three playgrounds, an Orion Spinner, and a sports shed. The facilities include the use of a hall and a church.
